Directions: (Visitors Center, Caesar Creek)

I-71 to Exit 45 (State Rt 73); West on SR 73 approx 4 miles, LEFT on Oregonia approx 3.5 miles, RIGHT on Clarksville approx 1.3 miles to Visitors Center, past Flat Fork Pavilion.

Rt 42 to SR 73, EAST on SR 73 approx 1 mile, RIGHT on Clarksville approx 2.4 miles to the Visitors Center.

#### Rules:

Paid registration for the cancelled Bull Run Road Race shall apply to this race. Pre-registration will be available on line via Truesport.com. Race day registration begins at 8:00 AM and closes 30 minutes before the race. Same day race registration will incur an additional \$10.00 day of event late fee.

- Competitor numbers are issued at registration.
- Full payout of prize purses greater than \$250 requires 20 entries. If less than the minimum, races may be combined. Depending on course conditions, officials have the right to split, combine, modify or limit any categories to insure a safe event.
- All events scored using a timing transponder—a \$25 deposit is required when issued. Deposit may be cash, check or a valid USCF license.
- Planned FINISH line is on Clarksville near Visitors Center; flat finish but the climb should establish a selection in the fields.
- There will be a King of the Mountains (KOM) points competition. Points for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd riders crossing the KOM point on each lap will be awarded 5, 3, and 1 point respectively. The rider with the greatest number of accumulated points shall be determined the KOM winner. The KOM winner in each race, excluding the Cat 5 race, shall receive \$50.00.
- There will be a Sprint points competition. Points for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd riders crossing the Sprint point on each lap will be awarded 5, 3, and 1 point respectively. The rider with the greatest number of accumulated points shall be determined the Sprint winner. The Sprint winner in each race, excluding the Cat 5 race, shall receive \$50.00.
- \*There is no State title designation for the Cat 5/Citizen race. We are offering a Cat 5 race in conjunction with this race. The Cat 5 place winners, and KOM and Sprint points winners will receive merchandise prizes.
- We are honoring our Bull Run Farms race registrants. Paid, registered riders of the cancelled Bull Run Farms Road Race will receive full registration credit for this race. The updated purse amounts reflect the redundant costs associated with offering a replacement race and race registration credit for our prior race. The purse remains fully funded.
